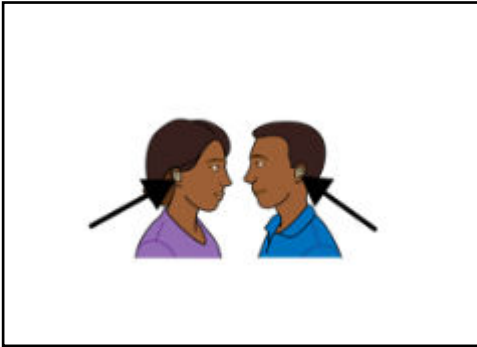
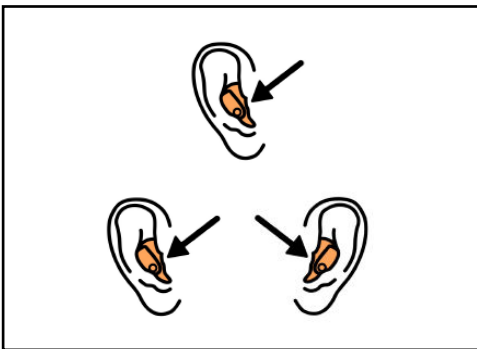


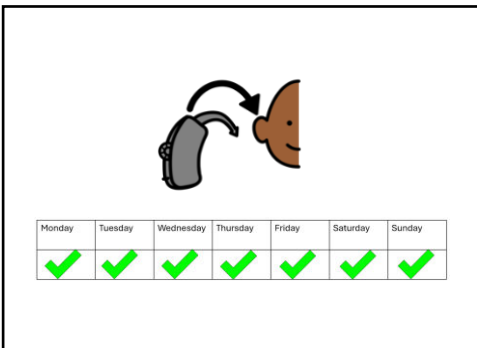
Wearing My Hearing Aids



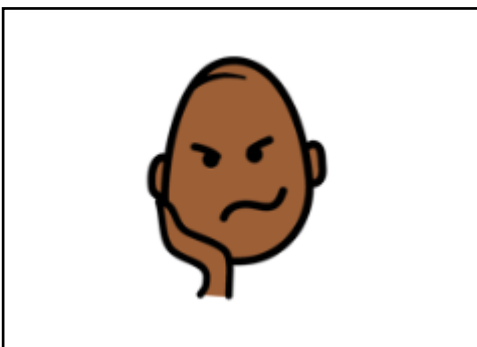
I have new hearing aids!



My doctor will tell me if I must wear one or two hearing aids.

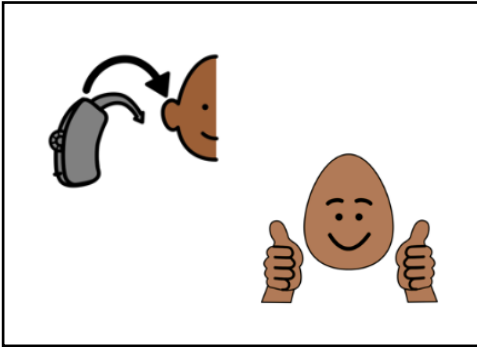


I will wear my hearing aids every day.

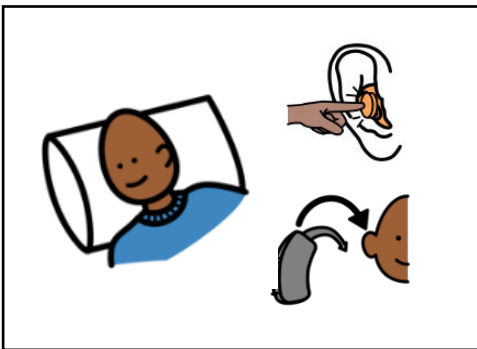


My hearing aids may feel funny at first. That is normal.

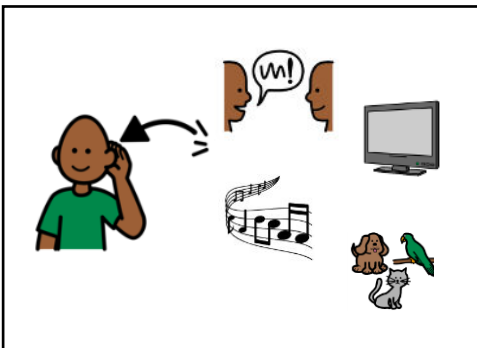
Wearing My Hearing Aids



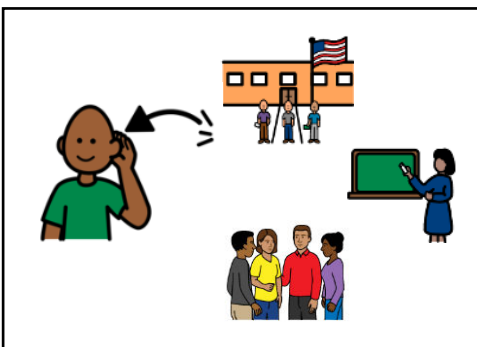
When I wear my hearing aids every day, I will get used to them and they will feel more comfortable.

I wear my hearing aids at home so that I can hear my family/housemates, the TV, music, and my pets.



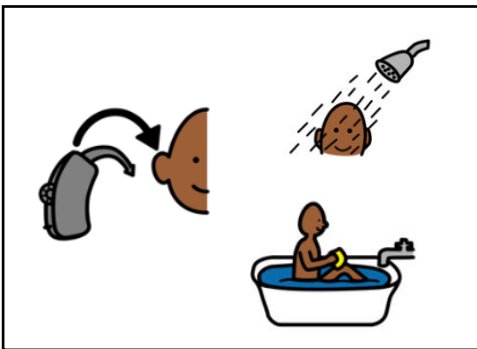
I wear my hearing aids at work, school, and my programs. My hearing aids help me hear the instructor/staff, my friends, and important announcements.

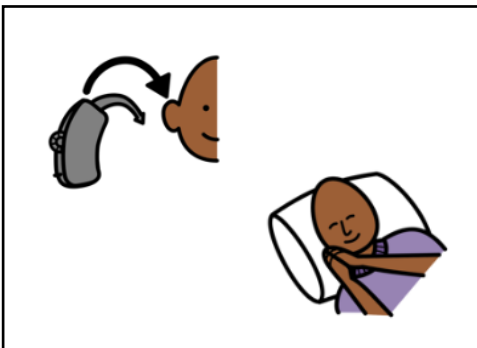

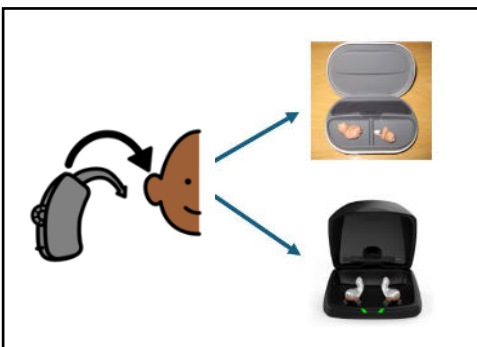

I take my hearing aids out when I take a shower or bath.



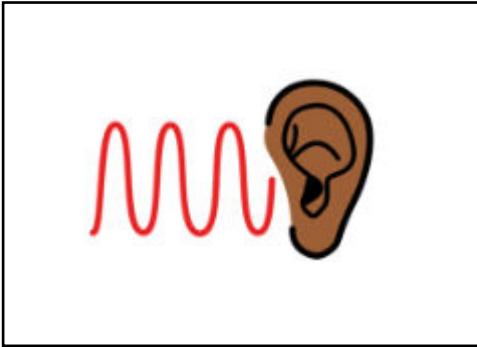
I also take my hearing aids out when I sleep.



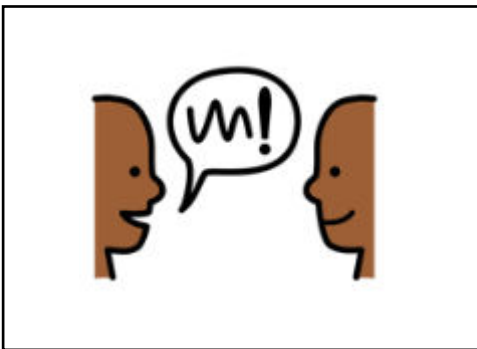

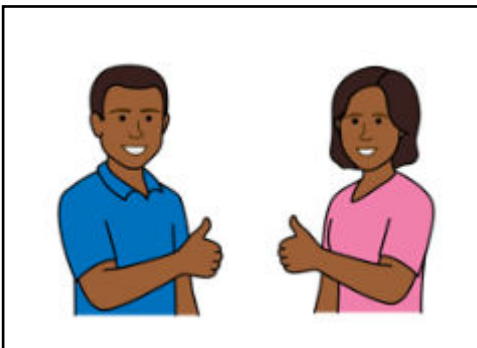


If I hear a beeping sound, that means the battery is running low.
